

Directions to Camp Always Get What You Want (CAGWYW)

To Get to Camp Mather from the Bay Area:

Take Highway 580 to 205 to Route 120 and follow signs to Yosemite! 120 makes a left turn in Oakdale, then right at Yosemite Junction, and bear right to stay on Highway 120, then left when 120 leaves 49, and turns left up Priest Grade. Continue on 120 through Groveland. Ten miles after Buck Meadows, turn left on Evergreen Road (Signs will also indicate that this is the turn off for Hetch Hetchy Reservoir and the Evergreen Lodge. If you reach the gates for Yosemite you have gone too far). Follow Evergreen Road 7 miles to Camp Mather.

To Get to CAGWYW from the Festival Gate:

Use the included map for reference, but after they take your tickets, you will be directed down Mather Road and around to Yosemite Trails Road. Yosemite Trails will be paved at this point and you will pass Birch Lake on your right. After passing Birch Lake you will pass a set of bathrooms and then the paved road will take a hard left. Instead of following the paved road (which will change names to "Rock in the Road") you want to continue straight and down the hill onto the dirt road, which is actually a continuation of Yosemite Trails Road. Continue on Yosemite Trails Road for approximately 200 guesstimated yards until you see a sign for Hidden Meadow Loop and take a right. Our camp located about 150 feet up into the "Y" created by the continuation of Yosemite Trails Road and Hidden Meadow loop. The camp is marked by an "X" within a circle on the second page of the included map. Park wherever you can and you will see a number or trailers surrounding 10x20 silver topped free standing awning with our CAGWY sign on it. If you cannot find us, but have made it as far as the "Y", just ask anyone where Camp Always Get What You Want is and they will likely know where to point you.
